Vizy-Brite Aerosol

A surface coating used to improve light reflection

Vizy Brite Aerosol is a high quality surface for interior and exterior application which dries in minutes and creates a reflective sheen upon any surfaces which it can be applied to which include metals, woods, ceramics and masonry.

Preparation:

Ensure surface is clean and dry free from grease, rust and dirt. Protect adjoining surfaces from overspray. Previously painted surfaces should be sanded smooth.

Before Spraying

Shake can well for at least 1 minute after the ball starts rattling and regularly during use. Temperature should be above 15°C. Lower temperatures and high humidity will slow drying.

Application:

Hold can upright 25 to 30cm from the surface. To ensure compatibility test spray on an inconspicuous area. Spray with a sweeping motion, parallel to the surface. Start away from and finish off the surface. Apply a heavy coat, should be applied to a heavy or 'wet' appearance in thickness, almost to the point of running.

Recoating:

Recoat after 3-5 minutes until desired effect is created.

Drying:

Dries to touch in 10 minutes.

After Spraying:

Prevent blocking by turning the can upside down and spraying until clear gas emerges. Also wipe front nozzle clean.

Risk:

Harmful by inhalation, in contact with skin and if swallowed. Intentional misuse by deliberately concentrating or inhaling contents can be harmful or fatal.

Safety Directions:

Keep out of reach of children. Avoid contact with skin and eyes, and avoid breathing the vapour. Provide adequate ventilation. If using indoors keep windows and doors open during use. Can may burst if exposed to sources of heat. Do not spray near naked flame. Keep in a cool place out of the sun. Do not incinerate or puncture the can even when empty.

Eyes: If in eyes, hold eyes open, flood with water for at least 15 minutes and see a Doctor.

Inhaled: Remove patient to fresh air.
